Lambeth Civic Quarter - Mixed-use urban renewal in Brixton, London is going to be detailed by Architect James Pickard. \ This new civic quarter is centered around the refurbishment and expansion of the 1908 Grade II listed Lambeth Town Hall. The project has reduced the Council's core office buildings from 14 to 2, reducing their carbon footprint by a third and saving taxpayers £4.5m a year. It has also received recognition from the Constructing Excellence National Awards winning in the Preservation and Rejuvenation category, along with nominations from the Building Awards, RICS Awards and AJ Architecture Awards.
